BAY PORT FISH SANDWICH FESTIVAL QUEEN & KING OFFICAL RULES 2019

- Contestants must live in the Sebewaing, Caseville or Fairhaven areas or attend/ have attended Elkton-Pigeon-Bay Port Laker Schools.
- Candidates must be entering their senior year of high school or up to 21 years of age before the festival and unmarried with no dependents.
- Candidates must complete the application form.
- The candidates are required to attend the interview.
- During the interview, judges will ask the candidates a series of questions. The candidates will be judged by their responses to these questions. There will be at least 3, but no more than 5 judges.
- The Queen and King will be required to ride on the Chamber float in the following parades:
 - * Bay Port Fish Sandwich Festival (August 2019)
 - * Elkton Autumn Festival (Labor Day weekend 2019)
 - * Pigeon Farmers Festival (July 2020)
 - * Sebewaing Sugar Festival (June 2020)
- If unable to obtain transportation to the parades, or unable to attend for any reason, they are responsible for contacting the President of the Chamber to discuss alternatives.
- The Queen and King will be required to crown their successors in the following year.
- The Queen and King will be required to work under the fish tent for at least 3 hours on Saturday August 3rd, 2019.
- The Queen and King will be required to be on the festival grounds and available on Sunday August 4th, 2019.
