BAY PORT FISH SANDWICH FESTIVAL OFFICAL RULES

- Candidates must live in the Sebewaing, Caseville or Fairhaven areas or attend/ have attended Laker High School, USA, Caseville or Owendale-Gagetown High schools.
- Candidates must be entering their **junior year** of high school or up to 21 years of age before the festival and be unmarried with no dependents.
- Candidates must complete the application.
- Candidates are required to attend the interview.
- During the interview, judges will ask the candidates a series of questions. The candidates will be judged by their responses to these questions. There will be at least 3, but no more than 5 judges.
- All candidates are expected to ride in the parade on Saturday, August 3rd.
- The King and Queen will be required to ride on the Chamber float in several area parades as follows:
 - Bay Port Fish Sandwich Festival (August 2024)
 - Elkton Autumn Festival (Labor Day weekend 2024)
 - Pigeon Farmers Festival (July 2025)
 - Sebewaing Sugar Festival (June 2025)
- If the Queen is unable to obtain transportation to the parades, or are unable to attend for any reason, they are responsible for contacting the Bay Port Chamber President to discuss alternatives.
- The King & Queen will be required to crown their successors the following year.
- The King & Queen will be required to work under the fish tent for at least 3 hours on Saturday, August 3, 2024.
- The King & Queen will receive a \$1,000 scholarship following their reign.
